SECTION II: CONDITIONS

1. Prospective bidders are advised to view the items, stores and equipment in liaison with the college before they bid for each item. This will enable them to arrive at the most reasonable and competitive bids.
2. Bid documents with further information may be obtained from the procurement office, upon payment of nonrefundable fee of **Ksh.1, 000.00 per document**. Completed quotations are to be enclosed in plain sealed envelopes and be deposited in the tender box at administration block main entrance on or before **9th Thursday September 2026 12.00 noon**.
3. Quotations will be opened immediately in the presence of interested candidates or their representatives who chose to attend.
4. Bids are based on **AS IS WHERE IS CONDITION** and the conditions of the items are not warranted by the college.
5. The bidder may quote for each item or each lot and may quote for as many items as he/she wishes.
6. Bidders who will be awarded contracts will be required to pay for items **within 7 days** and not later than 14 days failure to which the award will be cancelled.
7. Bidders will be required to collect the items they have paid for within 7 days after making the payment failure to which storage charges will be charged.
8. Items tendered for below the reserve price will be retained by the college.
